- 9:05 Sherry Elmes, UNCC, reported on the May 20<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup> meeting of the NC Institute of Disaster Studies.
- 9:10 Wayne Broome, Emergency Management, reported that the Governor's Crime Commission grant proposals are due June 4<sup>th</sup>. He also reported that Charlotte-Mecklenburg is receiving:
- ~ \$1,344,000 from Homeland Security
  - ~ \$5,800,000 from Urban Area Security Initiative
  - ~ \$7,000 from Citizen Corps
- 9:15 Glen Neimeyer, CMPD, reported on equipment that CMPD is purchasing with grant money to protect officers while they are carrying out their responsibilities during mass casualty incidents.
- 9:50 Wayne Broome, EM, reported that AHAC will begin announcing meeting dates to the public which means the committee will need to schedule meeting dates for the next year. He reported that there will be a 36 continuous hour bio-exercise during the week of June 21<sup>st</sup>. He announced that Charlotte has been asked to develop a catastrophic incident response plan and he asked the committee to think about how continuity of operations within their organizations would be impacted if a catastrophic incident were to occur.
